

DSD

❖ What is **DSD or myDSD**?



DSD is the Davis School District hub where you will manage all the logistical needs for your student(s) throughout their school experience. When they begin school you will create a login as a guardian to be used in the sign in page pictured above at https://mydsd.davis.k12.ut.us/Guardian.

What is DSD used for?



- Academics: Check your student(s) grades, attendance and additional academic options per teacher's and student's needs.
- Payments: Pay for required fees (registration), optional fees (yearbooks), and lunch.
- Tools: At times you may be asked to participate in a survey, sign a document, or schedule an appointment such as SEP conferences with teachers. These items, among others, can be found here.
- Signatures and appointments will also be made available on the login page under notifications.



- ❖ How do I support PTA?
 - There are two categories of PTA membership: Regular and PTA Plus. Regular is \$6 per family and Plus is \$20 per family. PTA Plus members receive discounts throughout the year on school t-shirts and book fairs. You only need to pay membership dues once per family, not for each child.
 - Simply pay one of the membership dues (Regular or PTA Plus) under the Payments section in your myDSD account to become a member and support PTA.
- ❖ What activities and resources does the PTA provide and/or sponsor?
 - The first and most important place our funds go to are the sponsorship of one field trip per grade during the school year.
 - We also help support many great programs and activities throughout the year such as:

- ❖ Do I need to be a PTA member to help with activities or volunteer?
 - No! We are grateful for any and all help we receive and welcome new skills and talents to assist our teachers and inspire our kids.
- If I am a member of PTA am I required to volunteer or participate in PTA sponsored activities?
 - No! We appreciate your support in choosing to pay PTA dues and support our funding to
 provide the wonderful opportunities for our kids and teachers at Windridge. If that is all
 you are capable of providing at the time, we're grateful for and welcome your support.
- ❖ How do I become a member of the PTA Board or find out about available PTA positions at Windridge?
 - Contact the PTA President for needs and available board positions. We are always looking for great help! This year's (2021-2022) president is Tiffany Williams. Contact info can be found in the office.
- Is there a deadline to join PTA?
 - No feel free to join whenever is best for your family. If you don't feel comfortable
 becoming a PTA Plus member at the start of the school year when you're paying a lot of
 additional school fees, but would like to receive discounts on items throughout the year,
 you can upgrade to the Plus membership during the book fair or any other time
 throughout the year.

- Do you need to have a student at Windridge to join PTA?
 - Anyone (grandparents, aunts, uncles, neighbors, etc.) who would like to support our Windridge PTA and the activities and resources we help provide can become either a Regular PTA or PTA Plus member.
 - Because they don't have a myDSD account they can contact a member of the PTA board and we will give them instructions for sign up and payment. PTA Board members are listed under School Information and Back to School and Back to School Packet.
